Stroller rentals at Disney World



OPTIONS

- 1. BRING YOUR OWN:** Most airlines will check your stroller for FREE either curbside, at the ticket counter or at the gate.
- 2. RENT A STROLLER AT DISNEY PARKS:** Rent a single or double stroller for the day or at a discounted multi-day rate. Must pick up a new stroller at each park.
- 3. RENT FROM A THIRD PARTY:** Independent companies offer single or double stroller rentals. Strollers are sanitized before use and delivered to you at your resort or the airport.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What size strollers can be taken to Disney World?

Strollers must be 31" (79cm) wide and 52" (132cm) long or smaller. As a reminder, wagons and stroller wagons are not permitted in the parks.

Are double strollers allowed at Disney World?

Double strollers are permitted at Disney World as long as they meet the above size requirements.



What do Disney World strollers look like?

Strollers are hard plastic, sport Disney theming and offer a retractable canopy and drink holder..



Can strollers be taken on Disney World complimentary transportation?

Yes! You are welcome to take your stroller on any of Disney's modes of transportation, including the monorail and Skyliner. Depending on its size, you may need to fold the stroller before entering some transportation vehicles, such as buses.

If I bring a stroller from home, where do I keep it at night?

You will find ample room in most Disney World resorts for storing a folded stroller. In many deluxe resorts, your stroller may even fit folded up inside the closet.

Are strollers permitted on Disney World rides?

In most cases, strollers are not permitted on Disney World rides. You will find stroller parking in front of ride entrances.

Are jogging strollers allowed at Disney World?

Yes, jogging strollers are permitted in the parks as long as they meet the previously mentioned size restrictions.
